



## Scuola Svizzera di Milano's Transformation From Association To Foundation

### Description

Lawal Legal & Tax Advisory assisted the Swiss School of Milan in its transition from the form of a Recognized Association to that of a Foundation under Article 42-bis of the Italian Civil Code and in the admission of Rahn Education Schweizer Schulen gemeinnützige AG, a Swiss nonprofit corporation, to the Foundation's management board.

In this way, the Swiss School of Milan takes on the name "Rahn Education Schweizer Schulen Foundation Milan" and, strengthened by the support of the Swiss Federal Office of Culture, new financial means and Rahn's network of more than 6,000 students, is set to face the challenges of the future.

The Swiss School in Milan is one of seventeen Swiss Schools Abroad directly monitored by the Swiss Federal Office for Culture and Education, and legally recognized as a Swiss school on Swiss soil. It was founded in 1919, since 1939 in the building at 21 Via Appiani in Milan. The School hosts about 300 students of different nationalities, making it to all intents and purposes a leading cosmopolitan School.

It represents excellence for its innovative teaching characteristics and teaching German as a first language; it is unique among Milan's Schools. Its students who have completed the baccalaureate (IB) can gain direct access to Swiss universities.
