

Aero Club Como's Board Of Statutory Auditors

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Antonio Micalizzi, Partner at Lawal Legal & Tax Advisory, has been appointed Chairman of the Board of Auditors of Aero Club Como.

The Aero Club Como, founded in 1930, is the oldest seaplane flying association in Europe. It runs the largest seaplane pilot flight school on the continent, both for those starting from scratch and for those who are already pilots and wish to complete their training with a hydro rating. Courses are for licensing (PPL), SEP SEA and SEP LAND ratings, and advanced hydroplane operations.

Aero Club Como's fleet includes 13 seaplanes and is the only one that includes all types: float- and hull-mounted, pure hydro and amphibious. With the latter one also operates over airports, as with any normal aircraft. Of particular interest are the historical hydroplanes, in perfect flying condition, which offer pilots the unique pleasure of using machines designed and built in the 1930s.

The Aero Club Como also operates the Como International Hydroscale, a documentation center, and offers consultations to agencies and operators in various countries of the world for the construction of hydroscales and the implantation of activities with seaplanes.
